



## FAQ: REOPENING OF CAMPUSES

### SERVICE TIMES

Everyone attending services indoors will be required to wear a mask at all times in accordance with county health ordinances. While we recognize some do not wish to do so or feel they are unable, for the sake of the greater community and varying levels of comfort, anyone inside the building must wear a mask at all times covering their nose and mouth. Those wishing to not wear a mask are encouraged to participate online at home, or watch/listen to a service at one of our campus' parking lots or patio areas.

We encourage high-risk individuals to attend the first service offered on either day.

There will not be online registration. Please join us for any service that you are available to attend.

Children are welcome to join their parents for the service. There will be activity centers for children in each auditorium at both the Loveland and Windsor campus. Children's sermon notes and coloring sheets will be available at each table.

### WEEKEND WORSHIP EXPERIENCE

The Worship Ministries of Foundations Loveland and Windsor will execute live weekend services in accordance with the current guidelines for physical distancing in both our proximity to each other, as well as our proximity to the congregation.

There will be three outdoor options: (1) WIFI at both campuses will be available in the parking lots to allow people to remain in cars to watch the service; (2) FM Radio will be available at both campuses. Tune into Loveland at FM 95.3 and Windsor at FM 95.5; and (3) Loveland's patio area will have outdoor speakers to listen to service.

There will not be an outdoor video screen at either campus.

**FACILITY & SAFETY**

In-person seating arrangements for both campuses will be clusters of chairs (2-person, 3-person, 4-person, etc.) all 6 ft apart.

All surfaces will be disinfected before and after each service, including chairs, door handles, bathrooms, etc.

Bioesque Botanical is the disinfectant solution being used at all campuses. It kills 99.9% of bacteria, viruses, fungi, and molds. Santizes soft surfaces in 2 minutes. It is EPA registered with no harmful chemicals. As well as being free of Chlorine, Phosphate, and NPE.

Social distancing will also take place in the lobby, or any other common area. Other instructions will be provided onsite to ensure everyone's safety.

No programs or message note sheets will be handed out.

No coffee will be offered, and public water fountains will be taped off. Please bring your own beverage. Garbage cans will be available.

**ASL & SPANISH MINISTRY**
